Guidelines for Submissions for Planeta Manglar Congress

GENERAL GUIDELINES

Within the framework of this scientific congress, the following presentation modalities will be accepted:

KEYNOTE LECTURES

Keynote lectures will be delivered by experts with international experience and high professional recognition. Each presentation will have a duration of 35 minutes, followed by a 10-minute session for questions and discussion, to foster an enriching exchange on the topic addressed. Presentations may be delivered in English or Spanish, with translation available.

ORAL PRESENTATIONS

Oral presentations are intended for the dissemination of case studies and high-impact projects within the four thematic areas of the congress. Each presenter will have 20 minutes to present their work. Presentations may be delivered in English or Spanish, with translation available, and will be selected by a Scientific Committee. At the end of each session, a panel discussion will be held with experts from each thematic area.

POSTER PRESENTATIONS (ONLINE)

Posters will be available in digital format on the official event website. Selected posters will be presented virtually, following an established schedule.



PARTICIPATION RESTRICTIONS

- Each author may register and present only one abstract as first author, regardless of the selected presentation modality.
- Abstracts must contain a maximum of 300 words, written in English, and must be submitted exclusively through the PLANETA MANGLAR website. The Scientific Committee of the congress will evaluate the abstracts and notify authors of their acceptance or rejection within the deadlines established in the official schedule, via email.
- During the registration process for the PLANETA MANGLAR congress, all participants, including applicants for oral presentations, poster presentations, and general attendees, must complete their online registration on the PLANETA MANGLAR website.

SCIENTIFIC POSTER PRESENTATIONS – DIGITAL FORMAT

In accordance with ESPOL's institutional sustainability policy, all posters must be submitted in digital format.

Selected works will be presented orally during the congress. Each participant must prepare their own slides summarizing the key aspects of the poster, respecting a maximum presentation time of 5 minutes, in sessions organized by thematic area.

RECOMMENDATIONS FOR POSTER CONTENT

- If multiple researchers are involved, their names and roles must be clearly indicated.
- The use of Times New Roman font is recommended to ensure uniformity and readability.
- Images must be well organized and have a minimum resolution of 300 dpi to avoid pixelation.
- Poster content should follow a logical sequence, including:
 1. The problem or need to be addressed.
 2. General objective.
 3. Proposed approach or methodology.
 4. Results and conclusions.
- Pay close attention to spelling and punctuation.
- Avoid overcrowding the poster with excessive information; select only the most relevant content.
- Use clear, coherent, and precise language.



STRUCTURE OF THE POSTER

PROJECT TITLE

Problem: Brief description of the need or situation addressed.

General Objective: Clear definition of the project's purpose.

Proposal or Methodology: Include a detailed description (in the case of a clinical case, describe the case).

Results: Relevant graphs, tables, or diagrams supporting the analysis.

Conclusions or Discussion: Main findings and their relevance.

Authors and Institutional Affiliation: Indicate full names, home institutions, and, if applicable, the research group or seedbed to which they belong.

Contact Information: Email address and other relevant contact details.

Graphs and Figures: Each graph or figure must be accompanied by a brief and descriptive title.

STRUCTURE OF THE POSTER

RECOMMENDED FONT SIZES

- Title of the paper: Font size 80–90, sentence case (bold).
- Subtitles (e.g., Problem, Objective, Results, Conclusions): Font size 30–40.
- Body text: Font size 30–40.
- Acknowledgements: Font size 30.
- These sizes represent minimum recommendations; if the content is brief, larger font sizes may be used.
